

### What's a Startup CEO's job?

At early stage, you may need to do one or **multiple** of these jobs yourself

As a tech person, you'll most likely be writing a lot of code

But you should always be looking to do **none** of them!

- Delegate to the best people you can find
- You don't want to be the bottleneck


Your most important job is to **lead**: your team, investors, customers


### Two Crucial Elements to Lead Effectively

Vision: a dream about what future should look like

Communication: convince enough people to join you in building the dream

### **Example: Human Evolution**





### Homo Neanderthalensis vs Homo Sapiens

**Bigger** brains

**Stronger** body

**Thrived** in climates we'd consider harsh

Existed much longer than us



Why the hell did we win?

### Cognitive Revolution of Homo Sapiens

We developed the ability to dream about things and convince others

We were able to work in groups of hundreds, yet Neanderthals in much smaller groups

Much of history revolves around this question: How does one persuade millions of people to believe particular stories about gods, or nations, or limited liability companies? Yet when it succeeds, it gives sapiens immense power, because it enables millions of strangers to cooperate and work toward common goals."

### Water Bucket Theory (Cannikin Law)

Planks = Skills a startup CEO has



Shortest plank determines the capacity of the bucket

### Reverse Water Bucket Theory



Find people with skills to make up for the "short planks"

### My Opinion



Startup CEO still needs to learn new skills, enough to recruit people with the right skills to make up for the "short planks"

#### What Kind of Mindset Do You Have?




I can learn anything I want to.

### Startup CEO is a Tough Job

Physically: long work hours

Mentally: lots of tough decisions to make

Financially: expected income is ¼ of income at big company

Why bother?!

### Two Kinds of Happiness

Everyday Happiness: "How happy are you these days?"

Life Satisfaction: "How satisfied are you with your life?"


### Everyday Happiness: Your Experiencing Self

More or less determined by your gene

Factors such as income, weather don't affect everyday happiness much

### Everyday Happiness vs Income

#### Happiness vs Income



### Life Satisfaction: Your Remembering Self

Determined by the "peak" and the "end"

My opinion: optimize for life satisfaction

### Life Satisfaction vs Marriage



### More advice on Happiness

Startup is long haul, not short sprint, so take care of your everyday happiness

Take care of your relationships

You'll receive a lot of rejections, but that's okay. Forcus on the yes

Enjoy the incremental achievements and learning in the process
