


Russian E-Commerce Market



2017 forecast: \$16,4 bn




E-Commerce Market USD



2017 forecast: \$16,4 bn, import - \$5,8 bn




E-Commerce Market: number of orders

Import Perspectives

- 1. Today parcels for less than 1,000 EUR or 31 kilo per month are duty-free for receiving by individuals. Since January 2019 (or a bit later) Russia will switch to EUR 500 duty-free threshold per month;
- 2. Since January 2021 Russia will switch to EUR 200 duty-free threshold PER PARCEL.

Today a lot of proposals to strengthen import norms are discussed, the most popular of them are:

- a) To implement an obligatory tax-registration for foreign vendors to charge VAT (18%);
- b) Reduction of duty-free threshold to 0;
- c) Charge VAT to the buyer (18%);
- d) Reduction of duty-free threshold to EUR 20 per month (like in Belarus);

Export from Russia was de facto launched in 2015 – exclusively for small businesses.
